Tiina Halmevuo is quality manager at the tenth largest VET provider in Finland, the Consortium Keuda Group. Consortium has 11 educational units, over 7000 students and adult participants and 620 employees. In addition to formal education, in all occupations, they provide training for businesses and development services for the region in which it is located. In the role of Quality Manager Tiina Halmevuo coordinates the internal and external evaluation of the Consortium, implementation of the development strategy, planning and assessment in teaching, international cooperation and mobility of participants, professional development of employees and some development projects.

Mag. Christoph Kimbacher is a mathematics and chemistry teacher and quality manager at the Höhere Technische Bundeslehranstalt Steyr, one of Austria's largest and oldest vocational schools, which will celebrate the 145th anniversary of its existence next year. He closely cooperates with the Austrian national reference point for quality assurance in VET - ARQA VET as a lecturer in the training program for quality managers of vocational schools, a quality peer, a counselor to schools in the peer review process and a mentor to the peers. Since 2015 he also works as a professor for didactics at the Johannes Kepler University in Linz.

Dr. Simona Bezjak is employed at the Center for Vocational Education and Training as a member of the national reference point for quality assurance in VET - EQAVET NRP in Slovenia. She primarily works in the programme "Establishing, upgrading and piloting of National Framework for QA of Education", in the process of preparation

quality indicators and steering material for quality management at the school and kindergarten level. She is also a member of a steering group of the programme, which guides the entire programme.
