
Sector-Specific QAG:


- In addition to Core QAG, specific guidelines reflecting aspects of structures and responsibilities specific to particular sectors.
- Eg. ETB QAG on 'Governance & Management of Quality' address balance of centre-level decision making and provider-level oversight.
- Sector-specific QAG produced for:
 - ETBs
 - Independent/PrivateProviders
 - Designated Awarding Bodies
 - Institutes of Technology

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


Further **Topic-Specific** Guidelines should be referred to where appropriate, depending on a provider's range and type of provision.












Outcomes

Engagement:

- Applicant completes application and Gap Analysis against QQI QAG.
- Independent Panel (1 x Head of Comparable Provider; 1 x VET QA experience; 1 x Teaching, Learning & Assessment; 1 x Sector/Industry Rep.; 1 x Report Writer).
- Evaluates against QAG as appropriate for provider context:
 - Good governance including sufficient externality;
 - Separation of commercial and academic decision-making;
 - Adequate resources human, financial, physical;
 - Methodology to obtain stakeholder views/benchmark continuous improvement.
- Presentation by Applicant; Site visit if required by Panel; Report to QQI.





Purpose:

- Encourage a QA culture & enhancement of the student learning environment & experience.
- Provide feedback to institutions about institution-wide quality and overall effectiveness of QA.
- Contribute to public confidence in quality of institutions by promoting transparency and public awareness.
- Facilitate quality enhancement by using evidence-based, objective methods and advice.
- Support systems-level enhancement of quality (e.g. through publication of synoptic reports).





QQI Higher Education
Periodic Review Process



Annual Institutional Quality Report (each academic yr)

 Includes baseline info. on QA policies, governance etc.; enhancement activities in reporting period; and plans for next year.

External review (7 yrs max.)

- Terms of Reference
- Criteria: ESG, QQI QAG & institution's own QA goals
- Self-evaluation informs dialogue with review team.
- External assessment and site visit by review panel.
- Publication of report.
- Follow-up on actions taken.



QQI planning process for periodic review of public VET providers': 2019-2020



- Research approaches to review of VET in other jurisdictions.
- Publish paper on international practice in periodical review.

Policy

- Work with stakeholders to determine review aims, model etc.
- Consult on and finalise policy.

ToR

 Work with stakeholders to develop Terms of Reference for review, outlining criteria, process, review team profile etc.

Handbook

 Work with stakeholders to develop Handbook for review to provide a detailed guide for all parties on the whole process.


Plan

• Develop an implementation plan to ensure effective planning and management of timings, staff, costs etc.


